

## Blocking Assignments

### ACT THREE SCENE TWO

#### GENERAL:

This is a short scene with very little complexities. The table is set and all of the players are on the stage as the lights come up. The visual image on the screen is of a dining room with a table set for guests. The window is used to show that the seasonal tree is outdoors.

#### ACTION:

The actions are self explanatory. When Brian and Bev exit they use ramp B and go to the rear backstage area. Karen clears away the table and uses the same counter as the cashier table which is situated at the back right corner of the stage. It is covered with a table cloth to alter its appearance.

#### PROPS LIST:

Table settings for five

Large table with five chairs.

A centre piece and other amenities for the occasion

Coat tree

Window

The seasonal tree for Winter.

#### STAGE DIRECTOR NOTES:

There are no special notes. All the players are on the stage together and the script covers their responses and actions. Karen and Jeffrey enjoy themselves and so does Brian. He sees a different side of Jeffrey and is more open to him and realizes that his mother is truly happy.

#### COSTUMING:

Nothing special needs to be costumed for this scene. Brian and Bev are dressed for a hockey game and pick up their coats from a coat tree that is situated near ramp B.

#### IMAGE SCREEN OPERATOR:

The image on the screen is a family dining room set for guests.

#### MAKEUP:

No special requirements for makeup.

#### LIGHTING:

The entire stage is well lit throughout the scene. The scene concludes with Jeffrey and Harvey talking about hockey together. Karen is very happily clearing things up. The image goes to black followed by the lights going to black. Karen, Jeffrey and Harvey all leave the stage under blackout by exit E.
